Texas Rangers conduct child porn sting



Landon Quinn Wright of Lubbock was arrested this morning by the Hale Center Police Department and the Texas Rangers on a second degree felony charge of attempted sexual performance of a child.

The Texas Rangers were asked to assist the Hale Center Police Department after a woman reported the suspect had contacted her via the Internet, and requested nude photos of her 7-year-old daughter. As the investigation progressed, the 25-year-old suspect requested to have sex with the child, in addition to purchasing the photographs.

The joint investigation, which began on August 30, culminated this morning when Wright agreed to pick up the non-existent “photographs” at a residence in Hale Center. He was then arrested and taken to the Hale County Jail. His initial bond was set at \$50,000. The charge is punishable by a maximum sentence of 20 years in prison and a \$10,000 fine. The investigation continues.

Agencies involved in the joint investigation include the Texas Rangers, Hale Center Police Department, Hale County District Attorney's Office, Hale County Sheriff's Office and the Hale County Constable Pct. 1 Office. Hale County is located just north of Lubbock County.
